Kit List for Year 6 Osmington Bay 12th – 16th July 2021

Clothing

- Night clothes
- Several changes of underwear
- 2 or more fleeces/jumpers
- 3 pairs of old trousers (**not jeans**) 2 for activities, one for evenings. Jogging bottoms are ideal.
- Long shorts for raft building activity – these shorts will get wet!
- Shorts (in warm weather) – however, for most of the activities the children have to wear long trousers and long sleeved T shirts.
- Several T-shirts – mostly long sleeved as these are required for many of the activities.
- Practical shoes or boots
- Socks (several pairs) including long socks so that trousers can be tucked into them for quad biking
- 2 or more pairs of trainers
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if you have them)
- Evening clothing to wear to the disco

Other essentials

- Labelled strong plastic bags (bin liners) for wet and spare clothes.
- Plastic bottle for drinks
- Torch and batteries
- Sunhat and sunscreen
- Wash bag and a towel
- Packed lunch for Monday 10th September in disposable containers.

This is the kit list recommended by PGL. When packing, please remember that the children will have to carry or pull their own bags up to the accommodation which may be uphill and some distance from the coach park.

Please note: The rules regarding the wearing of jewelry are very strict – children will not be allowed to participate in some of the activities if they are wearing earrings – for example archery. The instructors will not accept the earrings being covered with tape. It is recommended that children do not have their ears pierced over the summer holiday as they will not be allowed to wear any earrings for the activities.

Please do not send your child with any electrical equipment including i-pads, phones, hand held games as these will be confiscated and returned at the end of the trip back at school. Children can bring a cheap digital camera at their own risk but please note that children are not allowed to video any other children at any time during the trip.

NB: Please ensure all medication including sickness tablets for the journeys are labelled correctly and given to the first aider on Monday 10th September.
