- If it is a regular arrangement, one note will cover the whole period.



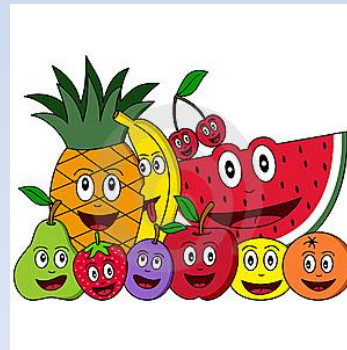
Lunch/break times



- Children are NOT allowed to access their lockers for the duration of break and lunch.

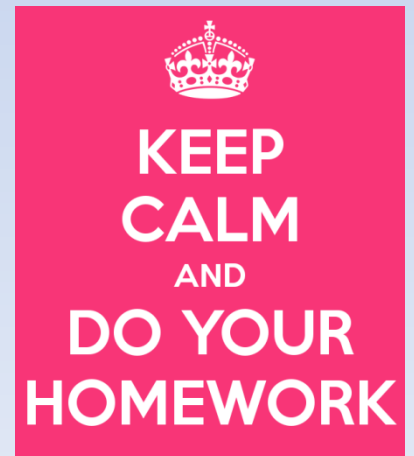
They can access their belongings at the start and end.

- No toys please!



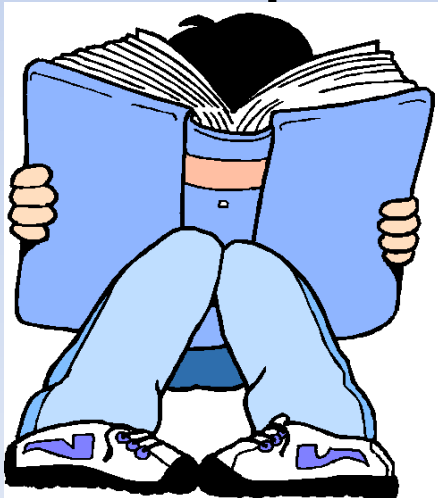
Homework

- Should be in every day, so if 1:1 reading takes place, it can be recorded.



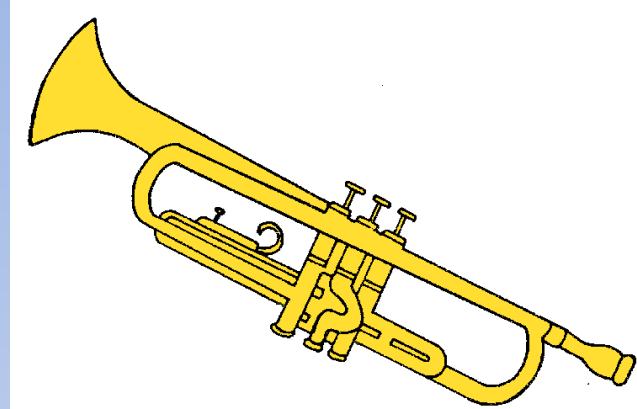
Hooke Court
