The Rules for Responsible Internet Use

As part of pupils' curriculum enhancement and the development of ICT skills, Christ Church Primary School is providing supervised access to the Internet, including e-mail.

Internet access is from the Education Authority who operates a filtering system that restricts access to inappropriate materials. All computer screens are in public view and as stated above, access will be supervised.

Should you wish to discuss any aspect of the Internet use or view the system yourself please telephone the school to make an appointment.

These rules will keep you safe and help us to be fair to others.

- I will only access the system with my own login and password, which I will keep secret
- I will not access other people's files
- I will use the computer for school work and homework
- I will not bring in floppy disks/memory sticks from outside unless I have been given permission
- I will ask permission from a member of staff before using the internet
- I will only e-mail people my teacher has approved
- The messages I send will be polite and responsible
- I will not give my home address or telephone number, or arrange to meet someone, unless my parent, carer or teacher has given permission
- I will report any unpleasant material or messages sent to me. I understand this report will be confidential and would help protect other pupils and myself
- I understand that the school may check my computer files and may monitor the Internet sites I visit.
